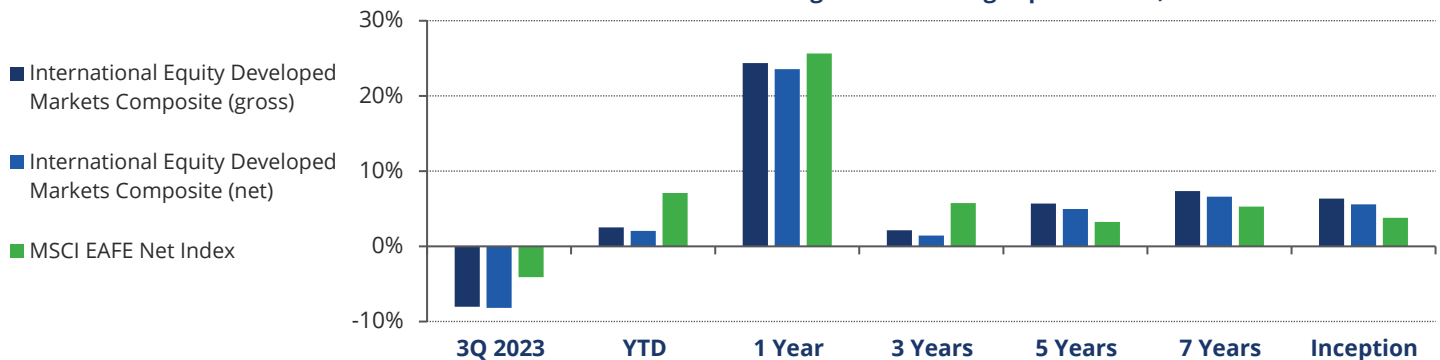
## Philosophy & Strategy

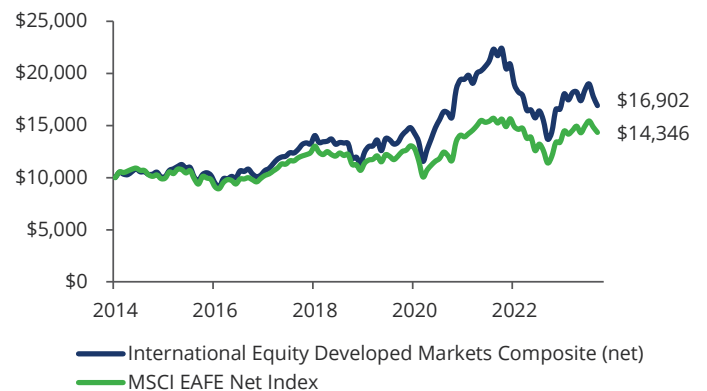
